National infrastructure law provides transportation grant opportunities for local & tribal governments.

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) –Alaska’s local and tribal governments have secured federal transportation grant funding for their local marine facilities, roads (AML) and Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF) partner and share resources to support local and tribal governments in transportation projects.

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (also known as the “Bipartite”) providing a once in a generation investment in the nation’s transportation and trails.
