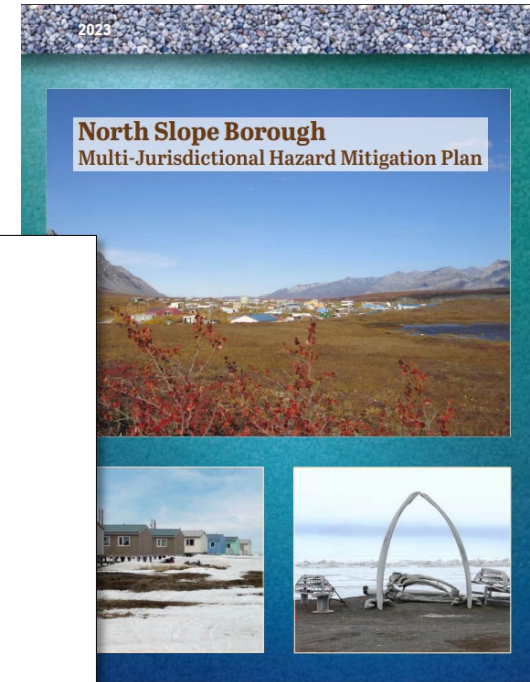
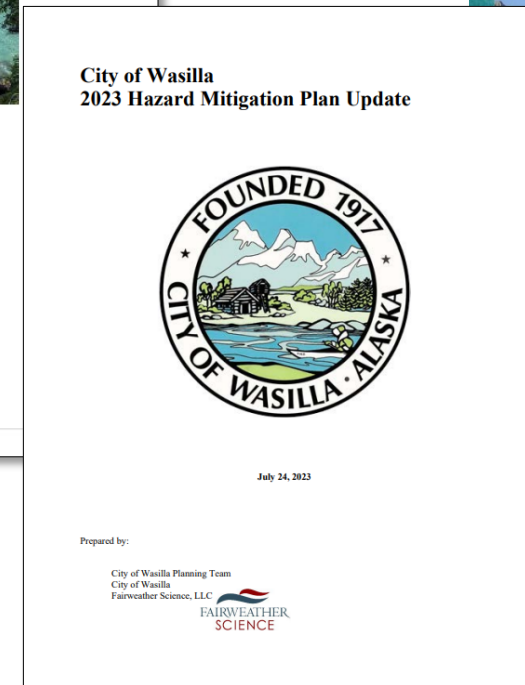
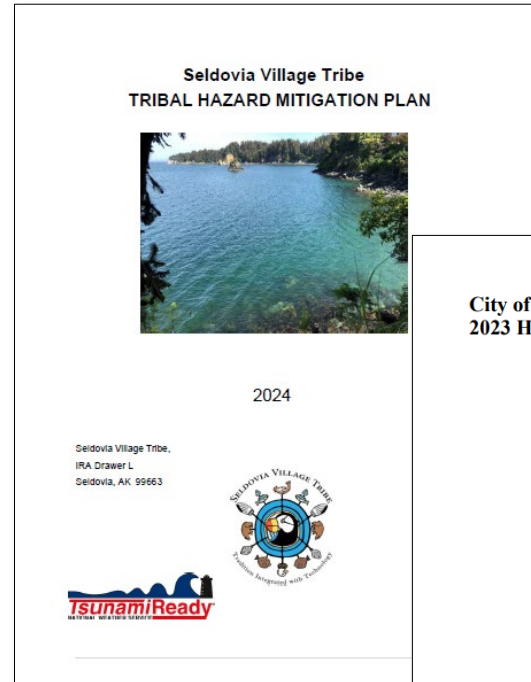

- Multi-jurisdictional (MJHMP)
- Approved HMP required to be eligible for certain FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) grant programs



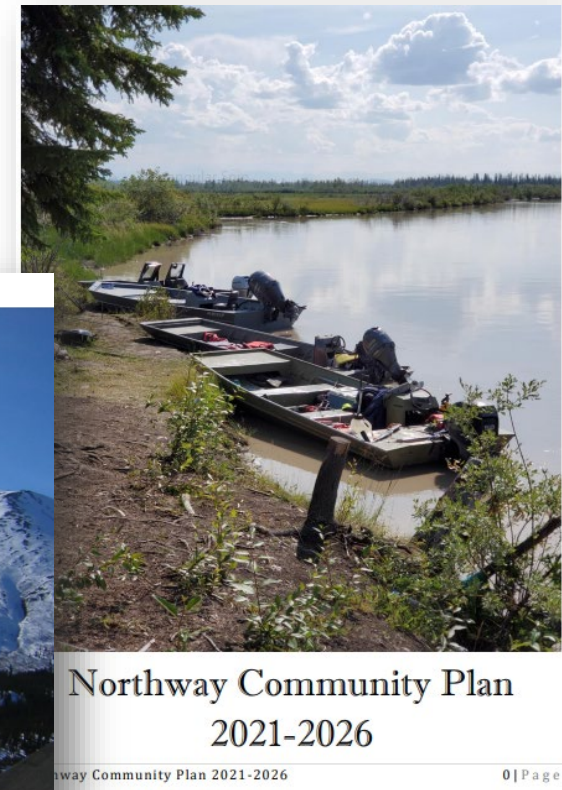
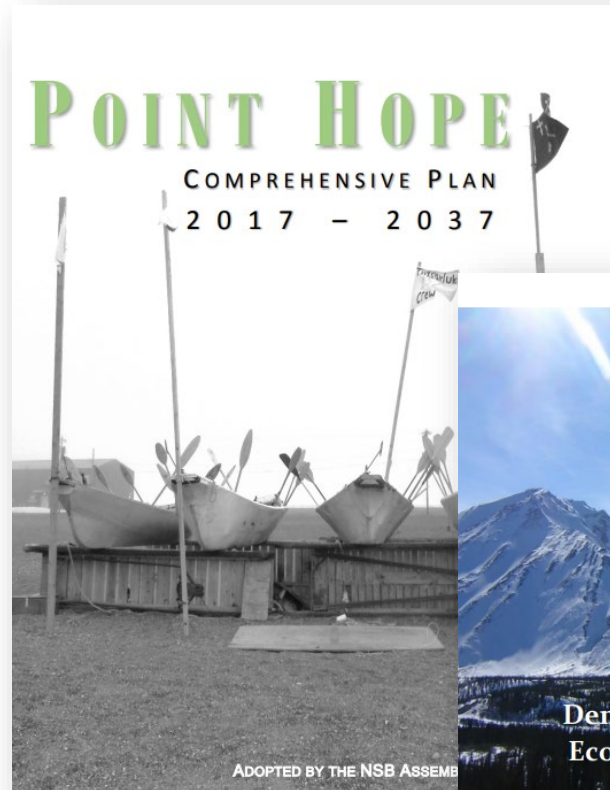
# Mitigation Plan Components



- Collective vision and goals to achieve resilience
- Input from a broad range of stakeholders
- Iterative public involvement
- Risk assessment of hazards, vulnerabilities
- Traditional Knowledge
- Current capabilities inventory
- Integration of policies and plans
- Prioritized mitigation actions
- Plan maintenance, changes over time
- Ongoing public outreach

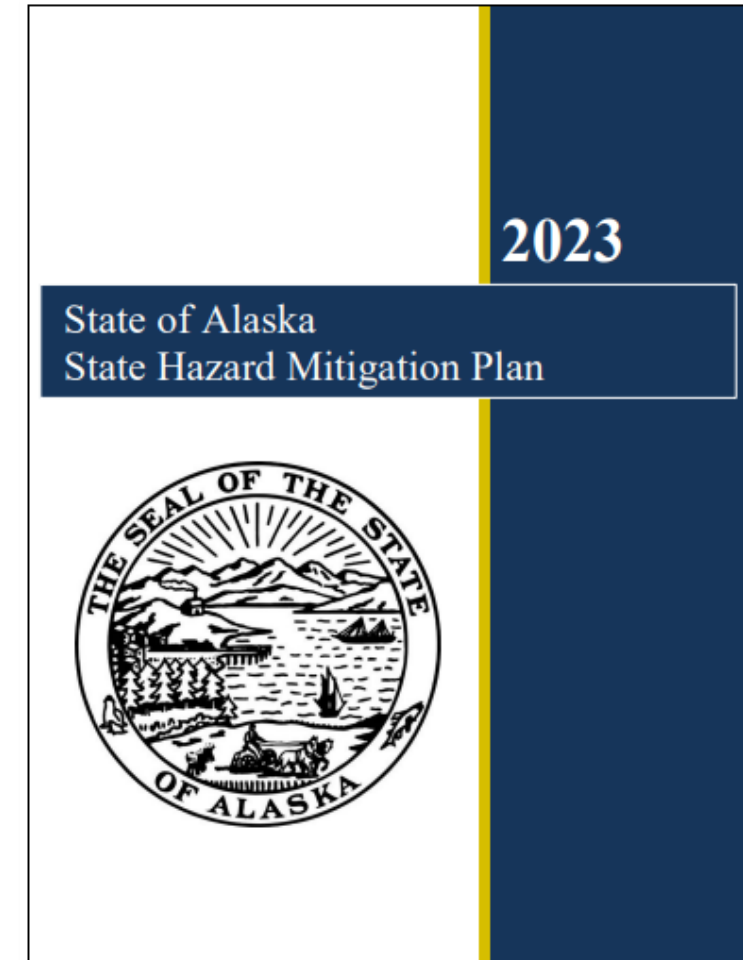
